

Jesus Christ- THE LORD

Main Scripture: Acts 2:36,

Supporting Scripture: Philippians 2: 6-11; Luke 1: 1-4,26, Luke 1:26 - 35, 38-55; Luke 2: 1-16,22,25- 34, 41-50; Luke 3:20-22; Luke 4:1-12, 16-22, 31 - 37; Luke 5:12-13, 17 -22,27; Luke 7:11-15; Luke 23; Isaiah 53:5; Matthew 4:16

Notes:

Christ came into this world, God so loved us that he gave his only begotten son. Does it matter who you are all you have to do is to believe in him.

Jesus is in control and what you need is Jesus. He is good.

To be a part of this family means we have to have an encounter with Jesus Christ. No man can come to God except through Jesus. Marvel not ... we must be born again. (John 3:7)

Peter made a statement to the crowd that was gathered for the feast of Pentecost. And the Holy Ghost came on the believers and created such a mind-blowing event that those who were gathered came to the place that the 120 believers were and in their conversation with Peter, Peter made this statement in Acts 2:36.

In Philippians 2:6, he saw mankind in their helplessness and so he didn't think of equality with God as something to cling to and took the humble position of a slave. He humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on the cross. To the Jews, it means much more than to the other nations because they understand the greatest name was Yahweh and so for Paul to declare Jesus' name was above every other name means his name was the name of God. Does it matter if someone refuses to accept it, the Lordship of Jesus will confess this to be true. Jesus Christ is Lord. The bible says that also in heaven everyone will bow their knees and also in the underworld will also bow that Jesus Christ is Lord.

Luke 1:1 - allows us to understand that the historic account is real we don't have many people writing fables but Luke writes for us to understand that there are many who have written about Jesus because his purpose is of utmost importance. Luke writes to a high-ranking individual and the purpose of this is to give an orderly and accurate account of the whole life of Jesus. So that he can be certain of the truth.

Luke presents the story of Jesus and begins with the account of what was taken place in Israel. The birth of John the Baptist and in Luke 1:26 - 35, 38-55

This baby will be called the son of the Most High. He will be born a King.

Is there anything too hard for God? A baby impregnated in you by the Holy Ghost and he will be called the son of God.

Don't quench what God is doing inside you sometimes you break out in a song like Mary.

When Jesus comes he comes to reverse the pride of mankind.

Do you want to be lifted up? Then humble yourself before Jesus Christ.

Luke 2: 1-16,22,25- 34, 41-50 the King wrapped in strips of cloth, born not in a privileged situation but he was a gift to this world. Even though he was equal with God he humbled himself because he was coming with a mission from mankind. There were shepherds guarding their flocks and they received the revelation.

Can you immerse your mind in this setting your out in your backyard and you see the heavens open up and begin to praise God? The shepherds went and found him and glorified God.

Eight days later the baby was circumcised. He was led to the temple and there was a man named Simeon who was led by the spirit. This man turned up because he was led by the spirit and so when the baby was to be presented he took the baby in his arms and said... now let your servant die in peace.

Even though Simeon was waiting for the messiah Simeon prophesies that this salvation is for all people. Yes, this message must be presented to the Jews but also to the Gentiles.

I want you to understand the promise that was given to Abraham includes all who believe as he did. I thank God that Jesus came into this world to give life and that more abundantly.

You should not perish but have eternal life. There is one who is born of a virgin he is the son of the living God his name is Jesus as I call him knees in heaven and earth bow and every tongue confesses he is Christ and Lord. When I call the name Jesus something is happening inside your being.

Luke 2: 41 Jesus is 12 years old and was forgotten as he was teaching in the temple.
Jesus grew in wisdom, stature, and favor of all the people.

Here comes John the Baptist in Luke 3 and he baptizes Jesus and Jesus was then lead by the spirit in the wilderness to be tempted by the devil and he fasted and when he ended his fast the devil came to him and tempted him.

Is there anyone trapped in a cycle of defeat I want you to hear the words of Jesus? The spirit of the Lord is sent to proclaim that the captives will be released. The fact that Jesus is here means God's favor is among us. You don't need any luck or good fortune. The fact that the spirit of the Lord is on Jesus the favor of God has come and when he finished reading (Luke 3: 20) he spoke with authority. When they listened to him they recognized his authority was not ordinary. Here is a man posted with a team and Jesus had not said anything to him but the word made flesh showed up and Satan recognized that the son of the living God was in the midst. He, born a king, Satan recognized this is the one and cried out for him to go away. (Luke 4: 34)

When you get the name of Jesus you don't need to beat your lips and wonder if it will have any effect. When you have subjected yourself to the Lordship of Jesus when you open your mouth and speak something has to take place. No wonder sometimes when we come into some places people start to jeer us and we haven't said a word. I wish you could understand and know who Jesus is. The demon saw him and knew him. He saw on who he has never seen in this territory he is the Holy One of God. And Jesus said to be quiet and come out of him!

I am reading the account of Jesus as was given by Luke. Jesus did not beat around with words when dealing with demons he said one statement and the demon threw the man to the floor and the crowd saw what they have never seen before and out of the boy the demon came without hurting him further. People amazed with what authority his words had that even evil spirits flee at his command.

In Luke 5:12- 13, Jesus is willing to make this man who is at the point of death to make him clean. Instantly leprosy disappeared.

Some of us our efforts to see Jesus is so minimal but in Luke 5: 17-22 there was someone who needed Jesus to tear off the roof. "Sins are forgiven?" This was a new concept for the Pharisees but Jesus asked them which is easier, and showed them that He had the authority to forgive sins and turned around and said pick up your bed and go.

Luke 5:31 - 32 he came for those who are in sin and need healing, he came to give life and show us the path to righteousness.

What do you think about this Jesus and his purpose to redeem man from their lost state?

Jesus is no ordinary man for when he was born in this world. Wise men came and worshiped him. John writes and says this of whom I am writing is the Lamb of God which takes away the sin of the world. The reason you are bound is because you haven't had an encounter with Jesus. At the name of Jesus, every knee will bow. This gospel will loose you and deliver you and set you free. I am speaking to those bound by suicide I come to release you in Jesus. Call the name Jesus!

I'm called not because I am qualified but because he chose me in Him. I present Jesus to you. We understand that after all the miracles that he came and saw a funeral possession and he spoke to the dead man to get up (Luke 7:11-15)

There may be a mission impossible but I preach Jesus and Him crucified to get up!. After the healing and deliverance and all the wonderful things then they accused him of blasphemy Luke 23 but Isaiah said he was wounded for our transgressions and by His stripes, we are healed (Isaiah 53:5) see his wounded body and be healed.
