Notes:

Men look on the outward appearance but God looks inward. There is nothing that qualifies a man to be anointed it is God's sovereign choice. There is nothing that any man can do to someone who the Lord has chosen. It doesn't matter if the person is a little child. if he/she is anointed of God. God doesn't invest in failure. What seems like a failure to men God will make it produce.

The spirit of the Lord departed from Saul when David was anointed.

David knew there was no miracle in the armor of Saul he knew where his miracle came from he knew where the anointing came from and he needed to feel that not the armor of a King.

Jealousy will place you in a position where the Lord will not communicate with you.

If you're praying and inquiring of the Lord and you've not heard anything. Deep down you're wrestling with the spirit of Jealousy so the Lord can't hear you.

a jealous soul is a bitter and corrupt soul, their soul is in the gall of bitterness.

The Jealous man only wants what he wants and never what God wants.

understand there is a church in the assembly. The church is not known by our meeting together. the church is joined together by one spirit. Everyone who is joined to that spirit functions in harmony.

everything happening here the Lord is allowing it to happen.

Saul in coming in contact with the witch placed himself in the terrible judgment of God. The spirit of jealousy is alive in this congregation. It is said that someone gave room for it to grow. Cut ties from the uncleanness.

Someone will say I won't go that far... but who knows where the spirit of Jealousy will drive you? straight in the house of a witch.

the scripture tells us that not all who says " Lord Lord "is of him.

I recall in Jamaica, a woman was running around the church speaking in tongues and many were deceived. The Spirit of the Lord led a missionary to tell the lady one word from the Lord. The Holy ghost runs the church and the church is spirit-led. The people of Israel were in bondage and the Lord displayed his mighty hand against Pharaoh but in the process of doing that the Lord hardened the heart of Pharaoh. All we need to have a hardened heart is for the presence of the Lord is to move away from us.

Saul did not completely destroy the Amalekites and so he was rejected as king. Still in the office but rejected and as soon as God selected for himself a man after his own heart the spirit of the Lord departed from Saul. How sad is it to not have the Lord's spirit over our lives?

Saul is now seeking to kill the man that is anointed.

A self-destructive behavior similar to envy is Jealousy.

Those of us anointed of God don't need to be scared of those who are jealous of what God has placed on our life.

It is not the camp of the Philistines that had the danger, the danger is within. - David's enemy was Saul his king.

What caused this jealousy? Nothing but the annoying on David's life. Samuel anointed David for service and the presence of the Lord left Saul.

The Jealous man is always strategizing against the people of God.

The anointing is a shield no one can touch the anointing. Only God will permit certain things.

Nothing can stop the church from moving through this land. It is powerful and it's victorious.

There is heart in a rage but you can be set free you have to believe the sovereignty of the Lord. No man can force God to speak or force anything from the hand of God.
